"I couldn't imagine changing a single thing, aside from finally getting around to sorting out the spare room."


Best advice

"Don't go it alone. If you have the budget, use a reputable interior designer, they bring their skills and expertise and a good set of tradespeople and suppliers."


A wall between the lounge and kitchen was removed to create a loft-like space. The authentic American fire-fighter hats and megaphone were eBay purchases.




The toilet walls are lined with pages from the books on the shelf.
